### Harrup Park Country Club, Mackay

**Client:** *Harrup Park Country Club*

**Construction completed:** 2009

**Construction costs:** \$3.8M

With the Harrup Park Country Club Innersphere set out to create a hospitality environment that would set trends in Mackay, where patrons felt like they could take time out and escape to.

With this in mind we employed a beach side resort feel for the majority of the refurbishment with the colours and finishes selected to create a feeling of escapism and luxury.

The steakhouse is more exuberant with bold colours, a heavy timber counter top with semi exposed aggregate concrete face and an oversized beef chart recalling a local neighborhood butcher's shop.

Custom low hanging pendants designed by Innersphere bring intimacy and warmth to the hospitality spaces.

The ramp dividing the cafe and steak house is lined with steel battens that provide movement and fluidity to each space, allowing patrons glimpses of activity between the two areas.

The floor to ceiling glazed walls allow for expansive views over the cricket pitches and deck and brings the exterior environment in.
